Users of the Y98, and Y99

Dear Parent / Career

Transport for Greater Manchester have been in contact with school this morning with reference about the procedure for using the above buses from Brinnington. They have informed us of a number of issues that they are having with some of the students that use this service.

To clarify what is required for students to use these bus services I have listed what they need below. This list is a requirement from TFGM and not Werneth School. It is your responsibility as a parent / career to ensure that your child meets these requirements.

An allocated place on the **Y98** or **Y99**

Each child is required to hold a valid **IGO Card**

Each child is required to hold a valid **Yellow Bus Pass**.

Each child that is eligible must have a **Free School Bus Pass**.

If your child does not have a valid IGO card or Yellow bus pass they will be required to pay the full fare to use this service.

I have been informed by TFGM that as from Monday 13th February 2017 the bus company will have to make sure that all students comply with the above requirements if they are to be allowed on the bus.

Students that do not have an allocated place on the Y98 or Y99 should use the Y69 (869) school service bus.
