Dear Parent/Carer,

Trip to Boulogne

I am delighted to inform you that we are proposing an educational visit to Boulogne in France for our Yr8 MFL students to enhance their learning experiences within school.

We will travel by dedicated coach, leaving school around 11.30pm on Thursday February 2nd, and returning at approximately 11.30pm on Friday February 3rd. As there is no overnight stay we will be sleeping on the coach. It is a demanding schedule, but a very rewarding opportunity for your child to use the language learned in the classroom.

The proposed schedule is as follows:

Travel overnight to Folkestone to take the Eurotunnel and in France at 9.30am local time.

10.30 am Friday 3 rd February	: Breakfast at traditional café in Boulogne. Students to order their food and drink in French to practise their language skills.
12.15 pm	: Visit to Boulangerie - Here the group can watch demonstrations on how traditional French breads are made, followed by a hands on bread making session
1.45 pm	: Return to Boulogne to visit old town, tourist information and lunch
3.30 pm	: Leave Boulogne to travel to Hypermarket for some shopping time
5.30 pm	: Check in at ferry terminal
11.30 pm	: Arrive back at Werneth

The cost of this trip is £99 which includes travel and insurance costs. We will be travelling with a group passport, so pupils do not need their own individual passport. Pupils should bring some snacks for the day as well as some pocket money for lunch on the Friday. Please note a non-refundable deposit of £39 will be required to allow us to secure the booking. Some financial assistance may be available – please contact me directly if you require further information regarding this.

Pupils will be in small groups with one of the four accompanying staff. Please note that during some activities pupils are *not* directly supervised by staff members (such as in the old town of Boulogne), but a member of staff will always be available at a designated point.

Due to the nature of some activities we cannot consider any pupil whose behaviour may be detrimental to his or her own safety, or that of others.

If you would like your child to be put forward for this trip, please retain this part of the letter and return the completed slip below to me via your child on **Friday November 11th**, together with a non-refundable deposit of £39 (cash or cheque.) If you have any questions regarding the trip, please do not hesitate to contact me on the telephone number below. Due to the balance of the trip needing to be paid to the tour company before Christmas, two further instalments of £30 would need to be paid on December 2nd and December 16th.

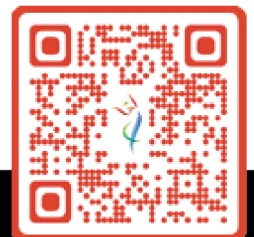
