In Life Learning we aim to give students the chance to take part in trips and activities that will give them the skills and knowledge that they need to be successful in later life. During the visit they will have a tour of the Houses of Parliament and see the following places:

- The House of Commons OR House of Lords chambers
- A visit to the public gallery to observe the MPs OR Lords working
- Westminster Hall, the last remaining part of the original Palace
- Central Lobby, at the very heart of the Parliamentary Estate

Students will also take part in a workshop after the tour.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Date: Tuesday 22nd November 2016

Travel arrangements: Train departs at **10.23am** from Stockport Train Station, arrive London Euston **12.24pm**. Depart London Euston at **8.00pm** and return to Stockport Train Station at **9.54pm**.

Meet time: **9.30am** outside the main entrance of Stockport Train Station.

Cost of the trip: **£15**. This includes return travel costs and inner city travel on the London Tube.

Students are to make **their own way** to Stockport Train Station and are to be **collected from there** upon arrival back at Stockport at **9.54pm**.

Due to security restrictions at Parliament students are only permitted to bring with them a small bag. Students must bring food and drink with them for the journey. We shall be visiting a fast food outlet after the tour where students can purchase food if they wish. Students must wear **FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM**. It is advised that students also bring an outdoor coat as the weather is forecast to be cold on the day.

Deadline for payment: Thursday 17th November 2016 the method of payment is via Parent Pay please.

All parental approval forms and reply slips must be handed in for students to be allowed on the trip. They shall be representing Werneth School at one of the most iconic and important buildings in our country so I trust that their behaviour will be perfect.
