Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, the existing school building will be forced to close to students on 12th October 2016. In order to recoup some of the lost learning time, we have looked at alternative arrangements for Year 11.

Thanks to our partnership with Adidas, we have been able to secure the use of an alternative building (the Reebok building which is adjacent to the Adidas site in Stockport) for Year 11 students on Monday 17th and Tuesday and 18th October 2016.

- Monday 17th October will be a Maths booster day
- Tuesday 18th October will be an English booster day

Students will be transported by bus to and from the Reebok building on each day. The buses will leave Werneth School at 9.00am and will return to Werneth School for approximately 2.00pm.

Students will be expected to wear full school uniform and bring their 'High Five' with them.

Each day will consist of two sessions of one and a half hours with a break in between. Students will be provided with a drink and crisps/snack during the break. Lunch will not be provided on either day.

All other subjects will provide work to be completed over the closure period. Staff have been asked to put this on the Show My Homework site as students will be unable to access the school system during the move to the new building. Parents and students were sent their log in details for this site at the start of term.

These two days combined with the first two days of term in September, which would normally have been staff training days, will mean that we have managed to recoup four of the closure days for Year 11. Please encourage your child to complete the work set to the best of their ability.

Details regarding the arrangements for returning to school will be sent home in due course.
